NEVER NEVERLAND LIBRARY PROJECT

TIAS ARMS is pleased to announce we have allocated \$23k to the creation of a library at Never Neverland. This library will be housed in a refurbished shipping container and is set to open at the start of the 2023 school year! Funds will be evenly distributed across books and program materials, furniture and fittings, and IT equipment, personnel and. a librarian.

This on-site library will supply students with a wealth of knowledge and access to computers for educational purposes. TIAS ARMS has hopes to expand the library by adding an additional refurbished shipping container to house all the computers available for nearly 160-180 students! There will also be a media library filled with music appreciation CDs and an introduction to various instruments.
